COVID 19 SCHOOL RESPONSE MEASURES.

During this unprecedented time, the Board of Management of Holy Family Secondary School will endeavour to do everything in its power to provide a safe and secure working/learning environment for all members of our school community. To this end, it is of vital importance that all members of the school community adhere to the safety measures that have been put in place for the health and safety of everybody.

The following behaviours will result in a student being removed from the school grounds and placed in the care of his parents/guardians until the management of the school is satisfied that the is no longer a danger to the health and safety of all/any member of the school community:

- Refusing to wear a facemask or appropriate PPE equipment as requested by the school's Board of Management.
- Deliberately and intentionally interfering with the face mask/PPE equipment worn by another member of the school community in a manner that compromises their safety.
- Deliberately coughing or sneezing in the direction of another member of the school community.
- Misuse of sanitisers and any other sanitisation equipment/personal hygiene equipment on the school grounds.
- Not following the clear directions laid out by the school e.g. Sanitisation procedures and general hygiene practices on the school grounds amongst others.
- Refusal to carry out any/all reasonable requests made by staff members, in order to prevent the spread of Covid 19 within our school community.
